Annual Subscriptions – Season 2026/2027

The Season starts on the 1st May, 2026 when subscriptions are due.

A Standing Order form is available for Gold & Silver subscribers only who wish to spread the cost of paying for the season in monthly instalments, however the final instalment must be paid prior to the 1st April, 2027. This facility is interest free. Members are reminded that hunt subscriptions are non refundable and anyone who undertakes payment by this method will be expected to complete their commitment.

GOLD HUNTER INCLUDING FIELD MONEY (Autumn Hound Exercise & Full Trail Hunting any day) **£1,500**
Summer Hound exercise and Hunt Hacks are not included as they are additional summer fund raisers. Gold subscribers may have 2 Guest tickets. They are also entitled to a day 'up front' with the Huntsman.

DISCLAIMER: Everyone must sign the disclaimer form which is available from the Hunt Secretary. This form will only need to be signed once but you will not be allowed to ride until you have signed it. You can either sign and email back to the Hon Secretary or give a paper copy to the Hon Secretary the first day you go trail hunting. Any day ticket (non subscribers) or subscribers guests must sign a disclaimer before they will be allowed to ride. Parents of children up to 17 years will also be required to sign a disclaimer form.

FIELD MONEY must be paid on the hunting day at the meet. Cash and card payments are accepted.

We require anyone intending to ride, to book in the with the Hon Secretary – deadlines are given with meet details. This will enable us to coordinate parking and catering

We have no reciprocal arrangements with any of our neighbouring hunts.
Please ring the Secretary of the neighbouring Hunt direct to arrange to go hunting with them

FARMERS FUNCTION : Please can every subscriber add a minimum donation of £20 to their subscription which will go towards a thank you to our Farmers and Landowners.

Members.

1. Right to vote at Hunt meetings and receive all Hunt literature. No trail hunting rights.

Children

Children are welcome at all meets but, apart from designated childrens' meets, must be accompanied by a responsible riding adult who must remain with them throughout the day.

Pony Club children wishing to trail hunt for the first time must contact their Pony Club DC. Non Pony Club children should contact the Hunt Secretary prior to the meet.

Subscribers' Guests

Subscribers may bring a guest out on 2 occasions but please speak to the Hunt Secretary before bringing out a guest.

Subscriber's companions who come out without prior notification will be required to pay a Day Rate Visitors Cap. No one will be allowed to trail hunt as a guest on more than two occasions in total.

Insurance

Trail Hunting has an element of risk and anyone who trail hunts should have adequate public liability and personal accident insurance cover.

British Hound Sports Association / Countryside Alliance Membership

Everyone who trail hunts with the Old Surrey Burstow & West Kent Hunt is required to belong to either the British Hound Sports Association or The Countryside Alliance. Membership of one (or both) of these organisations gives the necessary insurance for Hound Exercise/Trail Hunting.

Jorrocks Hunt Club

The Jorrocks Hunt club is the supporters club for the Hunt. It raises much needed funds to cover capital expenditure and through its Hound Sponsorship scheme raises funds for hound welfare.
